New Prior Authorization Process

Coming Your Way

On Nov. 15, 2024, BlueChoice HealthPlan, including Healthy Blue, will be making changes to the prior authorization (PA) process. While you will still sign on through My Insurance ManagerSM, the portal will route you to a new web-based application, powered by Cohere Health, that will enhance the efficiency of PA decisions.

These latest changes will only affect the authorizations managed by BlueChoice®. The PA process for our third-party vendors such as Evolent, Avalon Healthcare Solutions and Novologix will remain the same.

Benefits of the new process include the following:

- Accelerates and expands real-time approvals
- Enables a more seamless provider experience
- Decreases administrative efforts
- Meets new CMS¹ and NCQA² requirements that shorten the time for PA decisions

The new process will:

- Verify member eligibility.
- Verify the provider's network.

- Check PA requirements, including medical record requirements.
- Verify procedure and diagnosis codes.
- Expand fast-track approvals and real-time responses.
- Align with our clinical policies.
- Allow for digital submission of medical records.

What you need to do

To get ready, be sure to <u>register</u> with Cohere Health to access the new web-based application before the implementation date. If you already have an account with Cohere Health, you do not need to create a new one. You can continue logging in as usual.

There are also available <u>webinars</u> and a beneficial <u>learning center</u> that will help prepare you for the coming changes. We encourage you to review these resources at your earliest convenience.

Anesthesia Services **Updated Billing**

On **Aug. 20, 2024,** SCDHHS updated modifier-specific pricing for anesthesia services. The fee schedule for these services has been updated to reflect the change.

You will find that each modifier has its own pricing.

Healthy Connections NPI Registration

All South Carolina Medicaid providers must register their group and individual National Provider Identifer (NPI) with SCDHHS. Once approved, SCDHHS will assign a unique Medicaid provider ID number to each individual provider, group, facility or other entity. The requirements include but are not limited to the following:

- Application for NPI
- Screening
- License verification
- Completed application


Healthy Blue requires all participating providers and providers seeking to join the Healthy Blue network to have a registered SCDHHS NPI/Legacy ID for each NPI number.

Effective immediately, Healthy Blue will no longer accept

new NPI provider or group request for the network without a Medicaid ID number for the specific NPI noted on the request.
